

THOUGHT FOR 5th SUNDAY OF EASTER (27/28th April):
We cannot be a Christian by ourselves. To be a Christian means to share the life of the believing worshipping community. It means to play our part in building up this community, and in turn to be nourished by it very lifeblood. Cut off from the Body of Christ, our fruit will not last. Grafted onto the vine, we can bear much fruit.



 **First Reading:** (Acts 9:26-31). This reading tells about some of the trials Paul endured after his conversion.

 **Second Reading:** (1 John 3:18-24). Here John is reflecting on Christ's commandment of love.

 **Gospel:** (Jn 15:1-8). Jesus uses the image of a vine and its branches to illustrate how close are the ties that bind him to his disciples.

THOUGHT FOR 6th SUNDAY OF EASTER (4/5th May):
Such is God's love for us that He sent His Son. Such is His Son's love for us that he revealed to us everything that the Father had taught him. And such is our response to God that we serve Him not out of slavish fear, but out of gratitude for His goodness.



 **First Reading:** (Acts 10:25-26.34-35.44-48). This is part of an early sermon of Peter.

 **Second Reading:** (1 John 4:7-10). This contains what is probably the most important statement ever made about God.

 **Gospel:** (Jn 15:9-17). Jesus leaves us the supreme commandment of love.


